We present the City with the following collaborative requests if the annex is to ever be remodeled and/or torn down for redevelopment:

- That Para Los Niños, and all other tenants in the annex as of December 2019, be notified immediately of any intent or conversations for remodeling and/or redevelopment.
- That Para Los Niños, and all other tenants in the annex as of December 2019, be included in consultations, processes, and Community meetings regarding any remodel and/or redevelopment.
- That Para Los Niños, and all other tenants in the annex as of December 2019, be given priority to return as tenants to a remodeled and/or redeveloped building.

Thank you for your consideration and attention to this important conversation. We look forward to working with you all on this matter.
